

MASTER TRI-SIGNAL SET

The "MASTER TRI-SIGNAL" set was designed for simplicity in operation, service and to the art of signaling.

The "MASTER TRI-SIGNAL" set is a complete sending and receiving instrument and can be used singly or with another unit. To operate a single unit, insert any flashlight battery (not an expensive C battery) making sure that batteries touch both contact springs. Insert batteries so that the top of one makes contact on the bottom of the other.

Remove screws holding base and take base off carefully and insert batteries as mentioned above. Screw bulb into socket, close and you are ready to operate.

Put contact switch on any one of the three buttons and press key which gives signal.

1st: for telegraph signal

2nd: night blinker (used by Navy)

3rd: radio signal

Important - for Double Sets!

Put both batteries the same way in each unit.

When using double set for sending and receiving, follow above instructions and connect the two sets with two wires (using ordinary bell wire) from the top clip of one instrument to the top clip of the other instrument and from the bottom clip of one to the bottom clip of other instrument.

Scrape ends of wire clean before inserting in holes in clips. Do not let wires touch instruments, making sure of good contact. You can now send or receive over both instruments.

Operate key as follows:

Dot sounds are procured by quick tapping of sending key. Dashes are procured by holding sending key three times longer than for dot. Spacing between each letter, character or numeral is equal to three dots and between words to five dots.
