

PERFORATED PRACTICE TAPES

SET OF 10 TAPES especially prepared for the beginner, covering a practical course in code of 20 practice lessons. These are International Morse as used in Radio. None are available in American Land Line, telegraph code.

- #1 Fundamental letters and vowels in the order of their code construction.
- #2 First half, varied two letter combinations. Second half short words from letters in tape one.
- #3 Rest of alphabet in sections with practice words for each new letter.
- #4 & 5 Are analytic of the alphabet. Second half of 5 introduces numbers and is entirely numerical.
- #6 First half contains punctuations using the more important ones in plain text. Second half 5 letter and number combinations.
- #7 First half demonstrating rhythmic swing of code thereby helping student to more readily recognize letters, numbers, etc. by sound. Second half four character combinations mixed.
- #8 First half 4 letter alphabetically arranged words to develop speed. Second half 6 letter words for same purpose.
- #9 First half text outlining important points of Radio Act of 1927. Second half two messages commonly relayed in amateur field.
- #10 First and second half 5 letter alphabetically arranged words to develop speed similar to #8.
- #121 { SET OF 10 TAPES covering five character code groups, prepared for one of the Government
- #123 { Aviation Schools from their matter. The groups are progressive; starting with a few letters
- #125 { and numbers. The first side of each successive tape adds a few new letters and numbers mixing
- #127 { and repeating only the new material, the second side adds these letters and numbers to those
- #129 { in the preceding lessons mixing and repeating in varied succession the new whole. In this set
- #131 { each letter and number is heavily stressed at some point in the series, making them a valuable
- #133 { asset to the student who gets confused on certain letters or numbers. The set may be broken if
- #135 { desired but it would lose much of its value by doing so.

- #141 { SET OF 3 TAPES covering six practice lessons. Material is individual letters and numbers
- #143 { evenly spaced throughout entire length of tape. #141 is spaced for very low speed while the
- #145 { successive numbers are progressively spaced for increased speed to medium high. Set may be

- #147 Script at high speed. Second half script at medium speed.
- #149 { Five letter words medium speed.

- #155 Four letter code groups low speed. Second half six letter code groups low speed.
- #157 Five number groups very low speed. Second half five number groups low speed.

- #163 Five letter code groups high speed. Second half one to nine letter code groups high speed.
- #165 One to nine letter words medium speed.
- #167 Five number groups high speed. Second half six number groups high speed.
